

DECLARATION OF OPERATIONAL SERVICE FOR THE PURPOSES OF THE VETERANS' SUPPORT ACT 2014

In accordance with section 9 of the Veterans' Support Act 2014 ("the Act"),

1. I declare operational service:

- performed aboard Royal New Zealand Navy vessels or coalition naval vessels while deployed within the Operational Service Maritime Area Tahī, from 1 April 1991 up to and including 30 June 2024, to be operational service under the Act.

Operational Service Maritime Area Tahī - covers deployment at sea, in an area roughly defined by the following limits: Beginning at the Kathiawar peninsula on the west coast of India the operational area eastern limit follows a line extending south-west to a notional point in the Indian Ocean, a line extending due east from the Mozambique/Tanzania common border intersects this line forming the southern operational limit. The western border of the operational area then follows the Indian Ocean coast of Tanzania, Kenya and Somalia, north, before rounding the Horn of Africa. Here the operational area includes the Gulf of Aden, Red Sea, Gulf of Suez and Gulf of Aqaba. The operational area western limit then continues north, following the Arabian Peninsula coast to include the Gulf of Oman and Persian Gulf. The northern limit of the operational area follows east, along the coast of Iran and Pakistan to return to the Kathiawar peninsula in India. (Personnel must be on a deployment within the Qualifying Operational Area, and at sea.)

2. This declaration supersedes the declarations of operational service in:

- the Gulf of Oman from 1 March 2003 to 31 July 2003;
the Arabian Sea from 1 March 2003 to 31 July 2003; 1 April 2004 to 31 August 2004, and 1 May 2008 to 31 August 2008;
- the Gulf of Aden from 1 April 2004 to 31 August 2004;
- the Red Sea from 1 April 2004 to 31 August 2004;
- the Persian Gulf from 1 May 2008 to 31 August 2008.

3. This declaration covers:

- members of the New Zealand Defence Force (NZDF) serving with the NZDF;
- members of the NZDF on secondment with the armed forces of other nations; and
- any person seconded to the NZDF with the permission of the Chief of Defence Force.

4. The persons covered by this declaration shall have access to the entitlements and services specified in the Act and the Veterans' Support Regulations 2014.

5. I am satisfied that there was a significant risk of harm to those that undertook this service, as required by the Act.
